Subject: Automatic Ventilation During Interfacility Transfers

Associated Policies: 6511

- I. Policy
 - A. Only North Coast EMS approved automatic ventilator provider agencies may carry and employ automatic ventilators.
 - B. ALS provider agencies desiring to employ automatic ventilators must do so according to North Coast EMS Policy 6554 "Approval of New ALS Interventions."
 - C. Provider agencies may only be approved for the device/devices for which their personnel have been trained.
 - D. All provider paramedics must complete <u>at least 2 hours</u> of training on the use of the automatic ventilatory device for which they have been approved.
 - E. Automatic ventilator training must be conducted by a respiratory therapist, registered nurse or physician.
 - F. The training curriculum should include, at minimum:
 - 1. Indications
 - 2. Contraindications
 - 3. Physiology
 - 4. Pathophysiology, including the signs and symptoms of biotrauma
 - 5. Calculating Minute Volume
 - 6. <u>Time to empty calculations based on prescribed oxygen delivery rate and oxygen available on the transporting ambulance.</u> (Corresponding calculation tables should be carried on all provider ambulances.)
 - 7. Automatic ventilator provider device specific oxygen delivery mechanism and troubleshooting.
 - G. No paramedic may use an automatic ventilator for which their provider agency has not been approved and for which they have not received the 2 hours of required initial training or at least 2 hours of maintenance training within the previous 24 months.
 - H. North Coast EMS approved automatic ventilator provider agencies must maintain documentation of intial and maintenance training, including instructor signatures, for at least 4 years.

II. Indications

For the ventilation of patients requiring automatic ventilation <u>during inter-facility transfers</u> (IFTs) **only** as deemed necessary by the sending hospital physician.
