- 1. Maintain North Coast EMS Mobile Intensive Care Nurse (MICN) authorization and registered nurse license.
- 2. Initial review of prehospital care.
- 3. Direct observation of care via ambulance observation ride along.
- 4. Review of tape recordings and Prehospital Care Reports (PCR's) following guidelines noted in Section 2100 of the North Coast EMS policies and procedures.
- 5. Participate in the Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) process via evaluation of trended data to identify opportunities to improve care, including use of the Prehospital Care Reporting Database System (PCR-DS) to identify deficiencies and trends in patient care.
- 6. Counsel and develop educational offerings to meet needs identified for individual EMT's, MICN's and/or for the group and documentation of all remediations.
- 7. Maintain Continuing Education (CE) files and documentation as required for a North Coast EMS approved CE Provider.
- 8. Schedule and coordinate Field Care Audits (FCA's) and CE programs at least monthly.
- 9. Maintain files as appropriate for all EMT-II, EMT-P and MICN personnel for attendance at FCA's, ambulance ride-along observation, CE, monthly skills and incident reporting actions.
- 10. Provide scheduled opportunities for skills competency demonstration for EMT-II, EMT-P and other personnel, as needed.
- 11. Prompt notification to North Coast EMS of individuals in need of ongoing remediation or education outside the scope of the base hospital.
- 12. Act as liaison for draft or new North Coast EMS policies, procedures, or protocols and draft or new California state regulations and laws.
- 13. Review draft policies, procedures and protocols and provide feedback in a timely manner.
- 14. Maintain North Coast EMS Policy and Procedure Manual and treatment protocol Kardex.
- 15. Assist Emergency Department (ED) Director with development of base hospital policies, procedures, forms and systems.
- 16. Assist ED Director with assuring compliance with base hospital contract, including maintenance of a two-way telecommunication system and maintenance of the PCR-DS.
- 17. Assure prompt notification to North Coast EMS of problems related to contract compliance.
- 18. Orient new personnel to prehospital topics, including use of the PCR-DS.
- 19. Coordinate any incident reporting actions or remedial actions.

- 20. Liaison with EMT training programs.
- 21. Facilitate communication between MICN's, EMT's, ED physicians and North Coast EMS.
- 22. Represent base hospital at meetings, such as Emergency Medical Care Committee and Medical Advisory Committee.
- 23. Participate in EMS system planning and problem solving.
- 24. Participate in the annual hospital site visit.
- 25. The Prehospital Care Medical Director (PCMD) duties, are noted in North Coast EMS Policy #2109, many times overlap the PCNC duties, and that individual may be advisory to the PCNC.
